
PROFILE OF THE SPEAKER

Bharath Govind a Peer Educator, Researcher, Environmentalist, volunteer and Academic Mentor. He is the Cofounder and Chief Executive Officer of Climatehood Foundation, Thiruvananthapuram, Kerala. He is currently working in a Project funded by International Atomic Energy Agency-IAEA, Vienna, Austria on Clean Energy and Environment. This year, he has been selected as the 2021 Climate Ambassador by the Global Youth Climate Network of World Bank group and elected as the Global Focal Point for Task Force-2 , focusing on Universal Clean Energy Access and Generation . He has completed Master of Science in Organic Chemistry with 2nd rank from the Univerity of Mysore. After that he pursued his research at the prestigious Tata Institute of Fundamental Research, Mumbai. He was the social project Manager to the District Collector, Thiruvananthapuram and involved in Trivandrum Volunteership Programme, District Collector's Internship programme, Project C5, Sthithi etc. During Kerala Flood 2018,2019, Assam Flood Relief 2019 and Cyclone Gajja Relief he was the Volunteer Coordinator and Relief Facility Coordinator under the District Administration, Thiruvananthapuram. He was the first Convenor of Inter Agency Group, Thiruvananthapuram under District Disaster Management Authority, Thiruvananthapuram and played pivotal role in coordinatng Covid19 containment activities with the Govt of Kerala, especially in coordinating volunteers and NGOs & CSOs. When second wave affected the country, he formed a National Level Volunteer Network; SOS PPlatform;



CovidVolunteerNetwork to help the people in Distress. He has around 40 months of volunteering experience in the area of Environmental management and social activities. He is the recipient of many awards and recognition both from state and national level. He has been selected for the 6th National Science Conclave of Nobel Laureates conducted by IIT, Allahabad, India, from the University of Kerala. He has also received the Science Inspire Award from the Department of Science and Technology, Government of India, National Sevice Scheme Special Award etc.
